➤ ergoCentric's new airCentric 2 has upgraded performance features, improved comfort and an enhanced aesthetic.

Inspired by the breathability of mesh task chairs, the airCentric 2 combines the airflow of a mesh chair with the ergonomics of ergoCentric's foam and fabric seating. The airCentric 2's features include:

- Patented airflow technology
- Five inches of back height adjustment
- A molded back foam cushion for improved comfort of the air lumbar option
- An optional, patented, adjustable headrest with three pivot points and seven-inch vertical and horizontal adjustments
- An optional solid back cap for environments with stringent cleaning requirements
- The patent-pending tCentric armrest, available in four combinations of vertical, lateral and patented 360-degree swivel adjustments

“Our goal was to improve the chair's optional air lumbar support and its aesthetic, while also recognizing the importance of continuing to deliver the benefit of airflow and demonstrated ergonomic support,” said Terry Cassaday, owner and founder of ergoCentric.

Also available is the airCentric 2S, which comes with a multi-textured, solid back cap for health-care environments.
